Week Two Of The Reconstruct!

The Week Past

The Contractor removed the existing road surface on Casco Point Road from Shoreline Drive to Dunwoody, Carman Street and Frederick Street, and temporary water lines were installed along streets in phase 1.

Centerpoint Energy and Qwest started relocating their utilities in phase 1 as well.

We appreciate the patience and cooperation of everyone affected thus far.

The Week Ahead, May 10, 2009 Through May 16, 2009

The contractor will begin connecting temporary water to homes in preparation of water main replacement. Residents will experience one to two hours without water use during this process. The contractor will notify each resident prior to their water being switched. Some homes will see a black hose running from the road to an outside faucet. This is how your water supply is fed to the home. Other homes will have the temporary water hooked up at the water shut off near the property line. Tree removals will also take place early this week.

Centerpoint Energy and Qwest will be relocating their existing utilities. Qwest should be finished with their work mid week. Centerpoint will continue work on Casco Point Road, Carman Street, Frederick Street, Dunwoody Ave., Casco Avenue, Ethel Ave. and Caroline Ave.

Landscaping

As the project moves forward you may want to think about landscaping within or near the Right of Way if you

are within the reconstruct areas. With this project there will be excavations extending to the lot lines of most properties. If there are plants or other landscaping that you want to save you may want to transplant them in another location for the summer. Traffic

While Phase One is under construction we ask that you continue to use Dunwoody Avenue to enter and exit the point. Although one lane is open through Phase One, cars will remain cleaner, and construction will continue to move faster if vehicles do not travel through the construction zone on their way to Shoreline Drive (Co. Rd 15).
