## Let The Excavations Begin!

### *The Week Past*

The Contractor completed setting up the temporary water, removed trees and prepared for sewer and water installation.

Centerpoint Energy and Qwest continued working on relocating their utilities. Qwest completed their work on the project by the end of the week.

We appreciate the patience and cooperation of everyone affected thus far.

### *The Week Ahead, May 18 Through May 23, 2009*

The Contractor will begin installing sanitary sewer and water main along Casco Point Road. Traffic will be limited to one lane during this work. Access to homes will be limited when the utilities are being replaced across driveways. There may be periods of a few hours where temporary parking and walking may be required. All driveways will be accessible at the end of each day. The contractor will notify each resident individually prior to crossing their driveway.

The contractor will have two crews working in the area during the utility installation. Congestion in the area will increase, so we ask that you use caution and have patience when driving through the project and please follow directions from construction workers.

### *Landscaping*

As the project moves forward you may want to think about landscaping within or near the Right of Way if you

are within the reconstruct areas. With this project there will be excavations extending to the lot lines of most properties. If there are plants or other landscaping that you want to save you may want to transplant them in another location for the summer. ### *Traffic*

While Phase One is under construction we ask that you continue to use Dunwoody Avenue to enter and exit the point. Although one lane is open through Phase One, cars will remain cleaner, and construction will continue to move faster if vehicles do not travel through the construction zone on their way to Shoreline Drive (Co. Rd 15).
