Dunwoody Excavations Begin

The Week Past

The contractor paved the base asphalt on Carman and Frederick Street, prepared the driveways along Carman and Frederick Street, and continued work on sewer and water services along Casco Ave.

The Week Ahead, July 20, 2009 Through July 24, 2009

The Contractor will begin excavating unsuitable material from the street along Dunwoody Ave. on Monday, July 20th. Sanitary sewer excavations are tentatively scheduled for Wednesday, July 22nd. Access to driveways may not be available at times, and the contractor will work with each resident to vehicles out of driveways as necessary. Traffic will be routed down Casco Point Road to Co. Rd. 15.

The Contractor has tentatively schedule a water shutdown on Casco Circle for Thursday, July 23rd. A notice will be delivered to the homes affected in advance of the shutdown.

Driveways on Carman and Frederick Street are scheduled to be paved on Monday, July 20th. Concrete driveways in phase 1 will be replaced in approximately one and one-half weeks. Restoration will follow driveway paving this week.

Service excavations along Casco Ave. will be completed on Monday, July 20th, and street work on Casco Ave, Caroline Ave and Ethel Ave will follow.

Temporary Mailboxes

Temporary mailboxes for all areas under construction will be located on Casco Point Road at the intersection of Dunwoody Avenue. Casco Ave., Caroline and Ethel residents are currently using temporary mail boxes and Dunwoody Ave. residents will begin using temporary mailboxes on Monday, July 20th.

Garbage and Recycling Services

We have contacted the garbage and recycling companies that service this area to let them know they should continue to service their clients through the construction. If at any time they are unable to make it to a property they are to let the construction workers know, and the contractor will assist in carrying containers to the trucks. It is our intention to go out of our way to ensure these services are provided during construction. If your provider does not pick up as scheduled we ask that you contact them and let them know someone on site will assist them. You can also contact one of our project contacts listed under **Contacts**.

Other Residential Services

Residents with properties within areas of construction that have lawn services, tree services and similar services coming on a regular basis may have difficulties with access for their services. Trucks and trailers will not be allowed to park on streets while construction work is taking place. Please let your service providers know of the work taking place on the streets so they can plan accordingly. We ask that if any landscaping and other work on your property can be delayed, it is until the construction is complete in front of your property. Again, if you have any questions feel free to contact one of the people listed under **Contacts**.

Landscaping

As the project moves forward you may want to think about landscaping within or near the Right of Way if you are within the reconstruct areas. With this project there will be excavations extending to the lot lines of most properties. If there are plants or other landscaping that you want to save you may want to transplant them in another location for the summer. Beginning Monday, July 20th, 2009 you will begin using Casco Pont Road to enter and exit the point. Please use caution while driving since there will be residents stopped to get mail at mailbox banks along Casco Point Road, and final restoration taking place.
