Casco Point Road is Paved

The Week Past

The contractor continued with sewer and water work on Carman and Frederick Street. They also prepared Casco Point Road to be paved.

The Week Ahead, June 22 Through June 27, 2009

The Contractor will be paving Casco Point Road on Monday. They will continue with sewer and water on Frederick and Carman Streets. There may be periods of a few hours where temporary parking and walking may be required. Driveways will be accessible at the end of each day if possible. The contractor will notify each resident individually prior to crossing their driveway. You will also have excavations up to your property line in order for the services to be replaced.

The contractor may have two crews working in the area during the utility and street installation. We ask that you use caution and have patience when driving through the project and please follow directions from construction workers.

The contractor has scheduled the pavement on Casco Ave. to be removed on Wednesday, June 24th, and the pavement on Dunwoody Ave. to be removed on Friday, June 26th, weather permitting. Temporary water installation and tree removal will follow.

Landscaping

As the project moves forward you may want to think

about landscaping within or near the Right of Way if you are within the reconstruct areas. With this project there will be excavations extending to the lot lines of most properties. If there are plants or other landscaping that you want to save you may want to transplant them in another location for the summer. Traffic

While Phase One is under construction we ask that you continue to use Dunwoody Avenue to enter and exit the point. Once Phase 2 begins traffic will be routed through Casco Point Road, and Dunwoody Ave. will be closed for construction.
