Orono City Code Section 58-121 establishes hourly restrictions for certain operations, including construction:

Builders are reminded to be respectful of neighbors when conducting construction activity or a building project.

## Sec. 58-121. – Hourly restriction for certain operations.

The uses described in this section shall be limited to the times noted and as summarized in table 2 below:

1. *Domestic power equipment.* No person shall operate a garden or lawn tractor, power lawn mower, power hedge clipper, chainsaw, mulcher, garden tiller, edger, power device for bug eradication, drill, or other similar domestic power maintenance equipment except between the hours of 7:00 a.m. and 10:00 p.m. on any weekday or between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 8:00 p.m. on weekends and holidays. Snow removal equipment is exempt from this provision.
2. *Refuse hauling.* No person shall collect or remove garbage or refuse in any residential district except between the hours of 7:00 a.m. and 10:00 p.m. on any weekday or between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 8:00 p.m. on any weekend or holiday.
3. *Construction activities.* No person shall engage in or permit construction activities involving the use of any electric, diesel or gas-powered machine or other power equipment except between the hours of 7:00 a.m. and 8:00 p.m. weekdays or between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 8:00 p.m. on any weekend or holiday.

**\*Plans and permit cards shall be on site for all inspections.\***

TABLE 2: HOURLY RESTRICTIONS FOR CERTAIN OPERATIONS

Activity	Times Allowed on Weekdays	Times Allowed on Weekends and Holidays
Operate domestic power equipment	7:00 a.m.—10:00 p.m.	8:00 a.m.—8:00 p.m.
Refuse hauling	7:00 a.m.—10:00 p.m.	8:00 a.m.—8:00 p.m.
Construction activities	7:00 a.m.— 8:00 p.m.	8:00 a.m. - 8:00 p.m.
