- o Hazardous wastes including paint, cleaning chemicals, pesticides, petroleum products & fluorescent lamps
- o Recyclables that are collected curbside
- o Yard waste (leaves, grass, brush)
- o Water softener zeolite tanks
- o Barrels or drums that are not completely empty & do not have the ends cut out
