



City of Orono Snow and Ice Policy

With our early arrival of winter we want to remind all residents of a couple of our snow and ice policies.

- Parking on all Orono city streets and municipal parking lots is prohibited from 2:00 a.m. – 6:00 a.m. all year. When there is a 2” or more snow fall all parking on city streets is prohibited until cleared.
- The City of Orono will repair the damage done to a mailbox on city streets if it results being in contact with a snowplow. The city will not assume responsibility for damage done to a mailbox that protrudes in the street or by snow pressure or snow rolling off the plow or wing of the truck.
- If a fire hydrant is near your property please shovel it out and keep it clear for the fire department.
- Please keep your mailbox clear of snow to ensure mail can be delivered.
- If garbage or recycling pick up occurs the day it snows please try to keep bins off the street. It will make easier for the plow to clear city streets.
