Water Shutdown

Watermain construction will be taking place on Monday, May 10th.

Due to watermain work on Walters Port Lane, **water will temporarily be shut off to your home on Monday, May 10th. The shutdown will tentatively occur between 9 a.m. and 1 p.m.** Residents will be placed back on mainline water after the contractor finishes the watermain work within the roadway.

The time and day of the water shutdown is subject to change due to weather or contractor scheduling changes. Residents will receive further notice if such changes occur.

Once the water is back on, you should turn on a couple of different faucets and run the water for a few minutes (start with an outdoor spigot or laundry tub). You may notice air in the line and/or discolored water. This is normal and should be temporary. If problems persist, please call the number listed below.

In case of an emergency, the contractor will do whatever it takes to make the road accessible.
