Note: Set recyclables out in recycling carts by 7:00 am, leave out until 7:00 pm. (Do not place in plastic bags)

NO SORTING REQUIRED

Acceptable paper items:

- Newspapers and inserts
- Magazines and catalogues, envelopes - NO Tyvek or padded
- Mixed paper, junk mail, post-it notes, file folders
- Shredded paper-place in closed paper bag
- Gray paperboard, boxboard, egg cartons
- Hardcover, soft cover or paperback books or manuals
- Phone books, white/pastel packing paper, accordion files

Acceptable containers to recycle:

- Glass food & beverage containers (no window or ceramics)
- Aluminum & Metal food & beverage containers
- All Residential Plastics (Numbers #1-7 containers, lids and caps)
- Juice Boxes

Preparation Tips: Rinse & remove pumps and labels do not need to be removed

Cardboard needs to be tied in 3'x3'x16" bundles. (bundle cardboard)

Boxboard may be put with cardboard.

Acceptable boxboard items: (are ok to put with cardboard)

- Cereal, cake, cracker, chip, cookie & pasta boxes
- Shoe, gift & electronic boxes or soft drink or beer boxes
