- Caulking tubes
- Hazardous wastes including paint, cleaning chemicals, pesticides, petroleum products & fluorescent lamps
- Recyclables that are collected curbside
- Yard waste (leaves, grass, brush)
- Water softener zeolite tanks
- Barrels or drums that are not completely empty & do not have the ends cut out
